#### Next we ask your opinions on different family benefits.

Family leaves renewed 1.8.2022. Along the renewal there will be changes in the duration of the parental leave and division of the leave between the parents.

### K16a What do you think of the renewed duration of the parental leave?

Renewed parental leave can last maximum of 320 weekdays. The contingent can be shared in half between the parents (160+160) or it is possible to give from the contingent to the other parent, the spouse, child's other parent's spouse or other caregiver maximum of 63 weekdays. In single parent households the parent gets all the 320 days to use.

If all the parental leave days are used, the child is a bit over one year old when the parental leave ends. Before the renewal the child was approximately 10 months old when the parental leave ended.

If only one of the parents uses the maximum of the parental leave days, the child is same age when the parental leave ends as in the old parental leave model (which is approximately 10 months).

Along the family leave renewal employed parents can spend earnings-linked family leave in as many periods as they wish before the child turns 2 years old.

In addition, the flexibility to combine part-time job and parental leave has increased after the renewal. Part-time workday consumes half of one parental leave day whereupon the leave can last correspondingly longer.
